

HOW TO REACH US

Arriving by airplane

Public transport: Take bus number 79, exit at "Plieningen (Schleife)" - duration 12 min.

Taxi: Fare approx. 15 Euros. Time: approx. 15 mins.

Arriving by train

Public transport: Take U7 underground/tram line (leaving from low level station) towards Ostfildern. Exit at station "Ruhbank (Fernsehturm)", change for bus number 70 towards Plieningen, which stops at "Universität Hohenheim".

Taxi: Fare approx. 20-25 Euros. Time: approx. 25 mins.

Arriving by car

From Stuttgart city centre:

At Charlottenplatz (near the "Schloss" palace) turn from the B14 road (Konrad-Adenauer-Straße) into B27 (Charlottenstraße) and carry straight on. The road will become a dual carriageway later on. Take exit S-Hohenheim. Follow the signs for S-Plieningen/S-Hohenheim for some kilometres until you reach S-Plieningen. Turn left towards Hohenheim university. At next opportunity turn right. Follow the street until you reach the car park.

From Karlsruhe/Heilbronn:

Motorway A8, exit Stuttgart-Flughafen/S-Hohenheim, keep left and follow signs towards S-Hohenheim. In Plieningen turn left towards Universität Hohenheim. When you reach the traffic circle, take the first exit. Follow the street until you reach the car park.

From Munich:

Motorway A8, exit S-Plieningen/S-Hohenheim, keep right and follow signs towards S-Hohenheim. After approx. 4 km turn left towards Universität Hohenheim. After a sharp bend you will reach the university car park.
